Property Improvement and Maintenance Committee

- April 10: School age kids (Herons) will pick up sticks on the path and at the bottom area for their Discovery Walk Activity.
- The recent snow storm and heavy wind activity left three trees down/damaged. Luckily damage was fairly minimal.
- To encourage the use of the trail, we can have a monthly EFA trail walk where families are invited to walk the trail to enjoy the scenery and different seasonal changes. Include them on the monthly calendar distributed to families.

Fundraising Committee

- Cookbook Fundraiser (Alisa)
 - O Sent home another flyer with kids in April/May reminding families to send in recipes for the cookbook to encourage more participation before the deadline.
 - O Since we have about 50 recipes total so far, the deadline will be extended so that the printed recipe books will be ready in August instead of mid-May.
 - o Staff can help remind families to submit recipes if they have not already done so.
 - o Alisa will review recipes received to determine how many we have in each category and determine what types of additional recipes are needed.

- Alisa will also look into the publishing company that has created recipe books for local schools.
- Vendor Event Cancelled for this year.
- Food Truck Event Discuss at a later date.
- KidStuff Coupon Fundraiser
 - o Janice received information regarding KidStuff Coupon Fundraiser. The price has decreased from \$25/book to \$15/book with a \$6/book profit! Purchases are made through KidStuff Online Store using Educare's code. Books are sent directly to the purchaser and shipping is free. The fundraiser runs 3 weeks long. 30 days after the start of the fundraiser, KidStuff will send \$6/book to the center.
 - There are a good number of larger chain stores, theme parks, shops and restaurants included. See attachment for full list. Most coupons are valid through December 31, 2018.
 - o There is now a KidStuff Coupon App that can be used.
 - o EFA voted to move forward with the KidStuff Fundraiser. Wendy will look into it further.

Community Outreach

- Caroline Schrum Memorial (Mary)
 - o Many ELC families have reached out wanting to support the Schrum family.
 - Mary has collected photos of Caroline with ELC kids and has put together a photo book. One copy will be gifted to the Schrum Family and the other will remain at Educare for kids to view.
 - o EFA will also create a butterfly garden in her honor and would like to dedicate it around Earth Day (Sunday, April 22, 2018). A tree, a butterfly bush and an engraved plaque have been donated by families for Caroline's memorial garden. EFA selected a child-size butterfly bench and butterfly garden stakes to place in the garden. We would like to purchase a second bench after seeing/assembling the first one.
 - The Schrum Family has said they are overwhelmed by the love, care and support shown by the Educare family. They are very supportive of the butterfly garden idea. She loved butterflies and the outdoors.

Event Committee

- Family Potluck March 10, 2018
 - o The event was cancelled due to low participation.
- End-of-Year Picnic/Ice Cream Social May 19, 2018 (4-7pm, food served at 5:30pm)
 - o EFA will provide fried chicken, watermelon and bottled water.
 - Wendy will check on pricing from local restaurants (Watson's, Weis, Giant Eagle, Royal Farms suggested).
 - May be able to borrow a snow cone maker for the event. Janice will check with the family.
 - o Would request that families bring a side to share.
 - Need to think of vegetarian options.
 - o Kim will work on creating a flyer.

- Kim will check to see if Willy Woo Woo (clown magician) is available for this event and pricing (~\$350).
- o Kim will check on pricing of renting a moon bounce as an option.
